- **Mixed Aged Crews:** Each Crew will have 5 campers with 1 camper from each grade level 1st through 5th, 1 Crew Leader and 1 assistant Crew Leader.
- Each Station will have 4 rotations with 3-4 crews per rotation, which is about 20 campers per rotation.
- **Station Rotations:**
- **Sing & Play Peak-** Kids sing and learn about the Daily Bible point, Bible verse and Bible Buddy. "God Sightings" teaches kids to watch for God at work in our everyday lives.
- **Sticky Scripture-** takes Bible memory from the head to the heart.
 - Immerse kids in the daily Scripture so they will UNDERSTAND God's Word, APPLY it to their lives, and REMEMBER it for years to come.
 - Imagination Station-ignites imagination and wonder! Each day, kids experience faith-building, sciency-fun activities that create surprising faith moments. They'll make connections with the surprising faith moments and the Saint of the Day.
- **Bible Adventures-** is where God's word comes to life as the Daily Bible verses are acted out and kids dive deeper into their friendship with God!
- **Glacier Games-** kids play games that combine wild fun with meaningful learning about the day's Bible Point.
- **Tundra Treats-** provides kid-approved snack ideas your kids will enjoy as they pray together and review the Saint of the Day.
- **Compass Closing-** kids review the main points of the day and have fun singing and dancing.
- **Operation kid to kid-** Every year we pick a local nonprofit to educate the kids about and take up collections to support the group. This year we will be collecting donations for the Precious Life Shelter
